Children quizzed family members on their knowledge of the Stone Age, played charades to guess the Stone Age vocabulary and made a mini Stonehenge.



Our Christmas Tree










On behalf of POS and school, thank you to everyone who came and supported the fair.

On Monday 16th December, East Cheshire Hospice have invited us to take part in the Reindeer Rush to raise money for their charity. Antlers are provided!




If you and other family members would like to sponsor your child, please do so by following the link below. We have also contacted East Cheshire Hospice to ask for some sponsorship forms too.
