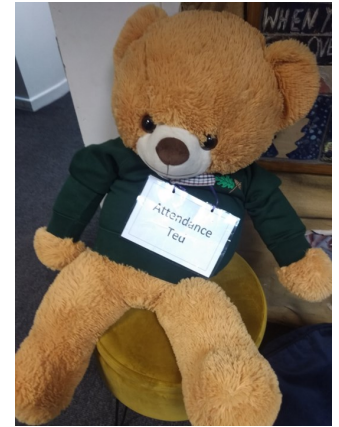

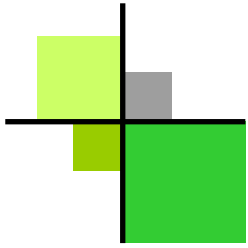
## Headteacher's Award

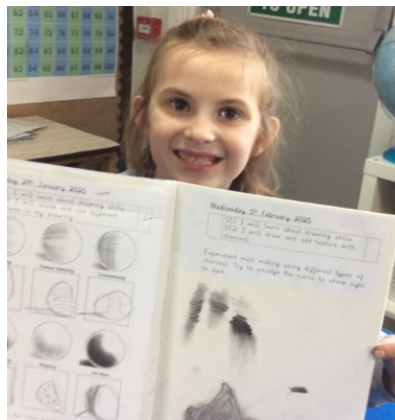
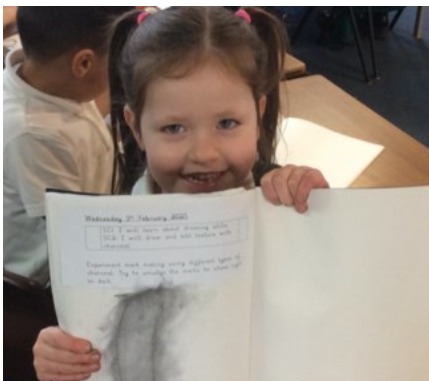
## Mr Smith's PE Awards

It has been an arty week at Styal.

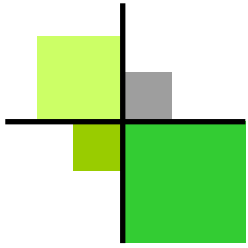
How fabulous are these iceberg collages?

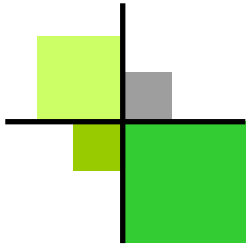
## Great Work
